A ZAMBIAN national was electrocuted by an electric fence after trying to outrun police in President Park on Thursday. The suspect died on the scene.

clothes into a hijacked truck

The truck was allegedly hijacked in Villiers in the Free State while on its way from Durban to Roodepoort on Thursday.

It is reported that Matrix Vehicle Tracking received a call about the truck, which was stationary in President Park for about an hour. Police reported that the truck was filled with clothes, shoes and bags worth R700 000.

Midrand police spokesman Inspector Mmakgoma Semono said the deceased was the driver of the truck. "Except for one Ethiopian, the 13 suspects said they were regular job hunters in Midrand and were called by the driver and his Ethiopian accomplice to assist with loading the goods," said Semono.

The suspects will appear in the Midrand Magistrates Court shortly.
